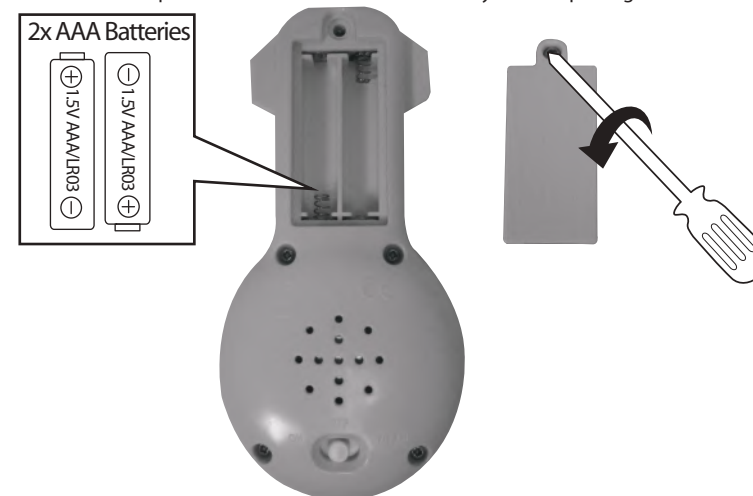

BATTERY INSTALLATION

The batteries included in your doll are for in-store demonstration. Before beginning, and adult must install fresh alkaline batteries. Here's how:

1. Open the hook and loop fastener on the doll's back and remove the battery compartment.
2. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove the screw and battery compartment cover.
3. Install two (2) fresh 1.5V AAA (LR03) alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated inside the battery compartment.
4. Replace the compartment cover and tighten the screw. Then, insert it back into the doll's back.

Make sure the heart button is in position with the heart on the tummy when replacing.

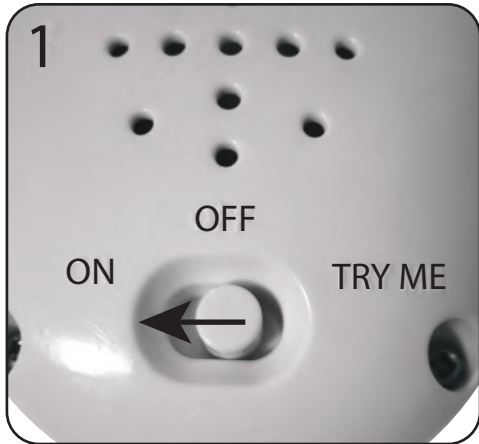

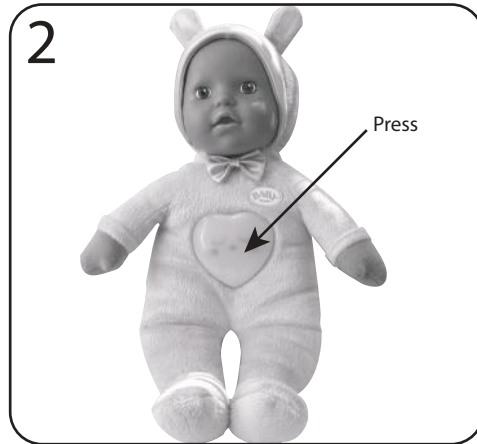

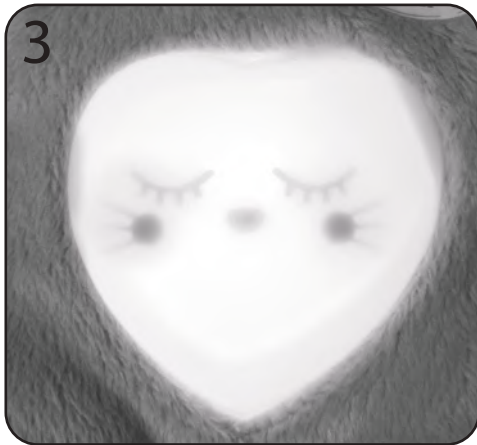
## QUICK START



Turn the switch located on the battery compartment from TRY ME to the ON position.



Press the doll's heart to play Rock-a-Bye Baby. The heart will light up.



Press and hold the heart for about one second to decrease the volume. To switch back, hold it for another one second.

To turn off the music, press and hold for approximately 4 seconds or until it turns off.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- To wash, remove the battery compartment from the doll and hand wash. Then, place the doll inside a pillow case and machine dry on gentle cycle.
- Do not leave the doll in direct sunlight for an extended period of time.
- Keep moisture away from battery compartment.
- Turn the switch from ON to OFF to conserve battery power.

## SAFE BATTERY USAGE

- Use alkaline batteries for best performance and longer life.
- Use only the type battery recommended for the unit.
- Batteries should be replaced only by an adult.
- Insert batteries with the correct polarity ( + and - ).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable batteries.
- Do not short-circuit batteries.
- When not used for an extended time, remove batteries to prevent possible leakage and damage to the unit.
- Do not mix rechargeable and non-rechargeable batteries.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be recharged only under adult supervision.
- Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire as they may leak or explode.

## FCC COMPLIANCE
